Security bars for 2 existing windows and 1 door	\$400

Reinforced walls - includes all electrical work and supplies (645.84 ft2)	\$4,950
Reinforced Ceiling (it works as the floor of the 3rd level, all electrical work and supplies included)	\$8,750
Ceramic floor installation and material	\$2,100
2 Windows and their security bars	\$450
Phase 2 total	\$16,250

Phase 3 – Third Floor	
Reinforced walls - includes all electrical work and supplies (565 ft2)	\$4,300
Reinforced Ceiling (it works as the floor for the terrace/patio over the roof floor, all electrical work and supplies included)	\$2,500
Ceramic floor installation and material	\$1,100
2 Windows and their security bars and 2 doors	\$875
Multipurpose room and patio (terrace over 3rd floor)	\$1,350
Phase 3 total	\$10,125

Project subtotal	\$37,275
Engineering (design and supervision), Paperwork fee and taxes	\$7,725
Total	\$45,000
